TOUR CITY ARTS SCIENCIES

IDEAS FOR THE CITY OF SCIENCES

* PANORAMIC EXTERIOR, OR INTERIOR VISIT

The City of Sciences is an open space in which the group can visit the main buildings outwardly, admiring its architecture, or enter some (or all) its enclosures. If you decide not to enter any area (Museum of Sciences, Hemispheric, or Oceanographic), our team of guides can accompany you from the outside. If you also want to include entrance to an enclosure, we can also guide you inside the Science Museum or the Oceanografic





* ENTRANCE TO THE OCEANOGRAPHIC

The largest marine park in Europe requires several hours for your visit, around 2-3 hours. If you have a whole morning, we recommend you to make an external visit of the City of Sciences for 1 hour approximately, and then spend 3 more hours inside the Oceanographic complex. In its interior are represented all the marine ecosystems of the planet, and you can discover species as unique as the white beluga, sea lions, penguins, walruses, sharks ... 500 different species of which we make a selection of the most curious ones. That way you can make the most of your time in the City of Sciences.



TOUR ALBUFERA VALENCIA

IDEAS FOR THE NATURAL PARK OF ALBUFERA

* BOAT TRIP

The logical and natural way of transport for an place surrounded by water. You will not forget the experience of going by boat in the Albufera Natural Park, through its ditches and canals and observing the rice paddies. You will also birdwatch a lot of species that choose the Albufera park as a place of passage and rest. It is also possible to sail in the middle of the lake, and feel the water surrounds us. And one announcement for those who are afraid of water: the boats meet the necessary safety requirements, and it is almost impossible to overturn, and in addition the average depth of the lake is 1 meter, the worst that can happen is to get soaked!





* Visit to BIOPARC

A good idea is to combine the Turia gardens tour with the visit to BIOPARC. Considered the "zoo" of Valencia, it is something more than that. It is an enclosure that introduces for the first time in Valencia the concept of 'zooimmersion'. It is a park in which the animals are not locked in cages, but they are free in open spaces but with limits and barriers. In this way, the visitor can observe different animals interacting among them and develop in a habitat more similar to nature. Species such as gorillas, giraffes, elephants, zebras, meerkats and lemurs make us transport to Africa without leaving Valencia.





VISIT TO MESTALLA, the home of Valencia CF and one of the oldest stadiums in Spain.

Our tour guides will share passionate insights into Valencia's illustrious past, with access to areas normally reserved for players and officials.

See the press room and the players' dressing room, and walk the tunnel to the roar of a capacity crowd.

The bodega is located in front of SOCCER INTER ACTION Headquarters in Enguera Valencia.

At present Bodegas Enguera possesses 160 hectares of its own vineyards, distributed between two specific areas. The first lies in the municipality of Fontanars dels Alforins, where we have approximately 60 hectares in the Casa Corones and Casa Lluch properties. The second is in the municipality of Enguera; there we have some 100 hectares located in various properties, the most important of which are the Antolín, Bañona, Benali, Toñuna and Venta Corrales.





VISIT TO XATIVA

Xàtiva is built on the margin of a fertile plain, and on the southern slopes of the Monte Vernissa, a hill with two peaks, each surmounted by the Castle of Xativa

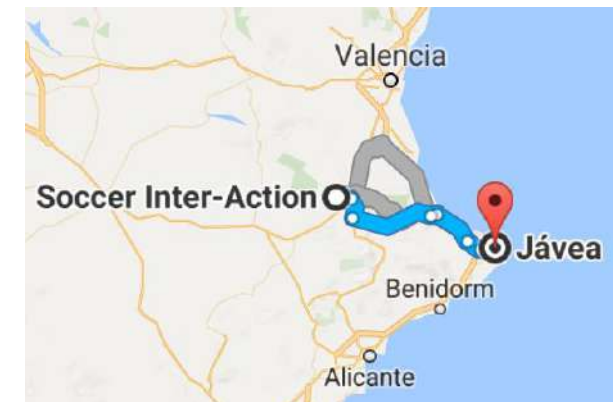

VISIT TO VALENCIA BEACH

Also written as Malva-Rosa is the most popular beach out of all the beaches in Valencia.

The **Malvarrosa Beach in Valencia** is a fine, golden sanded beach that is always lively with local residents and tourists. It guarantees a high standard of services that run along the beach on the **Maritime Promenade**, constructed in 1980.

It also offers a variety of restaurants and cafes. The beach provides several first aid postings and a bathing zone for the disabled. Because of its close proximity to the city and its vast stretch of open beach, it is home to **numerous activities and festivals**.





VISIT TO DENIA

Denia is home to a castle on a rocky crag overlooking the city. It was built in the 11th and 12th century and offers views around the sea, the city and the surrounding area. In the castle is the Palau Governador its museum.

The beaches of Denia are white and clean and the city lives around a beautiful port for fishing and luxury boats



VISIT TO JAVEA

Javea is a coastal town in the comarca of Marina Alta, in the province of Alicante, Valencia,, Spain, by the Mediterranean Sea. Situated on the back side of the Montgó, behind a wide bay and sheltered between two rocky headlands, the town has become a very popular small seaside resort and market town.

Javea coast is plenty of coves and small bays extremely beautiful.

The island of Ibiza lies some 90 kilometres (56 mi) to the east, and it can be seen on clear days
